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Definitions

"Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.

"Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.

"Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.

"On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.

"150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).

"150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.

"Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.

"Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

"Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.

"Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.



"Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

"First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program. "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.

"Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.

"Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.

"No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Official Withdrawal Process: The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and
obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session (first day of classes),
or the seventh day after enrollment (seven days from date when enrollment agreement was signed)
whichever is later. Right to cancel date:

- -The Notice of Cancellation shall be in writing and submitted directly to the Director or directors Ivan Contreras/Eddie Bello at 200 Atlantic Ave. Pittsburg ca, 94565, if sent by mail, it is effective when deposited and properly addressed with postage prepaid. A withdrawal may be initiated by the student's written notice or by institution due to the student's academics or conduct, including but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance. After the end of the cancellation period, you also have the right to stop school at any time and you have the right to receive a refund for part of the course not taken. Your refund rights are described in the Refund Policy and in the enrollment Agreement.
- REFUND POLICY—WITHDRAWAL PRIOR TO COURSE COMPLETION: Once the student has

been determined by the institution to have withdrawn from the course of study, refund policy calculations are performed under the two distinctive and different calculation formulas: The Institutional Refund Policy applicable to all students.

-INSTITUTIONAL REFUND POLICY: After the cancellation period, the institution will provide a prorata refund of ALL funds paid for tuition charges to students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance. Once more than 60 percent of the enrollment period in the entire course has elapsed (including absences) there will be no refund to the student. A registration fee of \$150.00 is a non-refundable item. Kits, uniform, STRF as well as any other items issued and received by the student would not be returnable or refundable. Once received by the student it will belong to the student and will represent a liability to the student. If you cancel the agreement, the school will refund any monies that you paid, less any deduction for registration fee and equipment received. If you withdraw from the school after the cancellation period, the refund policy described above will apply. If the amount that you have paid is more than the amount that you owe for the time you attended, then a refund will be made within 45 days of the official withdrawal. If the amount that you owe is more than the amount that you have already paid, then you will have to arrange with the institution to pay that balance. Official withdrawal date is on the student's notification or school's determination. You must cancel in writing. Students do not have the right to

cancel by telephoning the school or by not coming to class. I have read and understood this agreement Initial 5 Unofficial Withdrawal Process: For unofficial withdrawals a student's withdrawal date at a school that is required to take attendance is their last day of physical attendance. The date of determination is 14 days after they cease attendance. All refunds will be calculated based on the student's last date of attendance. Any assessments due to a student who withdraws shall be refunded within 45 days of the determination of withdrawal, whether officially or unofficially. In the case of disabling illness or injury, death in the student's immediate family, or other documented mitigating circumstances, a reasonable and fair refund settlement will be made. If permanently closed or no longer offering instruction after a student has enrolled, The Institution will either provide a full refund of all funds paid or completion of the chosen course at a later time to be determined by The institution. If the institution closes permanently and no longer offers instruction after a student has enrolled, the school will provide a pro-rata refund of tuition to the student. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.
